SCHEDULING ORDER

Pursuant to Alaska Commission on Judicial Conduct Rule 14(a) and the authority granted to the undersigned by the Commission, a pre-hearing conference was held on May 19, 2026. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The hearing on this matter will begin at 9:00 a.m., on December 3, 2026. It is anticipated at this time that the hearing will take one day.¹ The hearing will be held in a courtroom at the Anchorage Court Complex; the exact location will be disclosed closer to the hearing date once a specific courtroom has been designated.

2. Witness lists shall be exchanged and filed with the Commission by July 24, 2026. The witness lists shall identify a mailing address and/or phone number to facilitate


contact. Witness lists shall be supplemented in a timely manner if previously unidentified witnesses are identified through discovery.

3. Discovery allowed by Alaska Commission on Judicial Conduct Rule 12(c) and Alaska Civil Rules 26 – 37 shall be completed by October 20, 2026.

4. Any motions shall be filed by October 5, 2026. Oppositions, replies, and requests for oral argument shall be due according to Alaska Civil Rule 77.

5. The parties shall exchange exhibits no later than November 6, 2026 and shall endeavor to stipulate to admissibility of exhibits, to the maximum extent possible, to minimize time spent at the hearing. (*See* Civil Rule 16(c)(3)).
